This training encourages a move from note-taking to *rendering practices* that enable clients and therapists alike to come to novel and useful understandings. Rendering practices provide ways to stay close to clients' experiences as we inscribe their expressions in and on their terms. How might we render clients' expressions to align with what they place value upon? Rendering practices support listening and question-smithing in ways that can bring connected, relaxed, ethical, enlivened and effective conversations.

This training is designed for licensed and pre-licensed mental health professionals, students, case managers and others who keep clinical records. We will engage in new learnings, practice together and may even surprise one another with how we might shift our understandings of how we sit with those who have sought our consultation.
